Dear Parents

After School Club Arrangements

The start of the Spring Term brings with it the opening of the all new after school club facility which also will double as the Drama Studio, among other activities, during curriculum hours. This facility will be in use from the first day of term and I would like to make you aware of the arrangements in place.

Pre-prep after school club boys will be collected at 15.35 (from the Pre-prep Department) and taken with their bags and coats across to the after school club. Two members of staff will supervise this 'journey' along the marked pedestrian walkway **around** the car parking area.

May I ask that parents wanting to collect boys at this time are promptly available as the Pre-prep department can no longer offer supervision after this time and all 'remaining' boys will join the after school club. The reason for this (in part) is that we are looking into enhanced/additional extra-curricular provision for Years 1 and 2 which will involve the Pre-prep staff.

Similarly at 16.10 two members of staff will supervise the boys joining after school club at this time (Post Activities Pre-prep and Year 3) and they will be collected from the Pre-prep Department.

Boys from Years 4 to 8 can make their own way to the new building but can only use the marked pedestrian walkway **around** the car parking area. Form teachers will remind boys of this arrangement and I will ask that parents please reinforce this, it is imperative at this busy time we keep the boys off the tarmac parking area.

The after school club access is from the car park side of the wall and boys can be collected from there. There is a telephone in the after school club and calls can be put through to the supervisor through the main school office.

I would like to thank all those parents (and boys) who have kindly donated board games to this club but would add that we are still very keen to build up a small library of books and reading material in the after school club so any contributions of second hand books will be very gratefully received.
