Royal Academy of Art, London – David Hockney Exhibition

We have the opportunity to visit this important exhibition on Monday 30 January before the Year 8 boys take their art scholarship exams in March. There will be places for a maximum of 8 boys from Year 8 and 7 with priority given to the boys taking scholarship exams this term. We will travel by train to London to visit this exhibition, touring the exhibition with a personal guide, sketch and explore the RA and have lunch at Pizza Express (the RA has no lunch-room facilities).

17.00 (approx.) return to School – this will be confirmed when we book the train tickets/seats.

We will be walking and traveling on the tube around London, so the boys need to be equipped for this.
