Alterations to Winter Tennis Coaching Programme New schedule start from Monday 7 November

After one of the most successful seasons of results, the Tennis Club unveils its winter programme, to be run by top performance coach, Martin Butler (PCA – LTA qualified). Martin will be offering tennis lessons to all pupils on the school courts throughout the winter in group sessions and on an individual basis.

These sessions are proving to be hugely popular, with as many as 45 pupils undertaking coaching throughout the week. With the daylight hours shortening, these sessions will now be run at lunchtimes on the following times.

The individual lessons are being offered at £15 per half hour and the group lessons at £5 per hour. Payments to be made directly to Martin or placed on the school bill. We would ask that pupils sign up to an individual or group session at the same time every week and give at least 48 hours prior to the lesson if you are unable to attend.

In addition, Martin will be offering a free session from 9 – 12pm on Saturday morning to all those pupils taking individual or group lessons. This will involve a good deal of match play, allowing Martin to assist with tactics and reinforce the techniques being coached.
