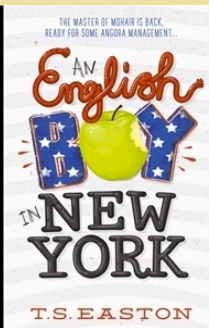
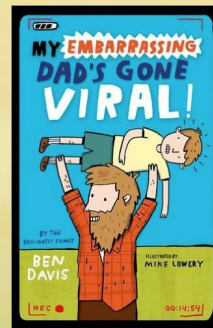
Eleven year old Gregor falls through a grate into the dark of Underland, a subterranean world which threatens the existence of his own. Read it? Try...
