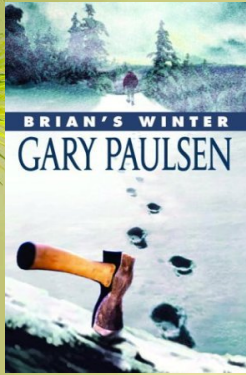

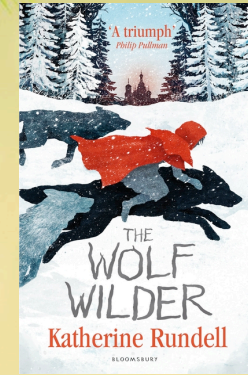


In *Hatchet*, 13-year-old Brian learned to live alone in the Canadian wilderness. But what if he hadn't been rescued and had to survive the winter...?

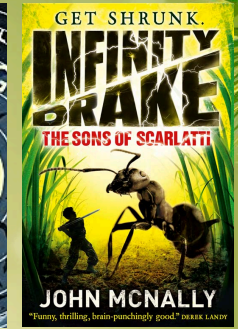
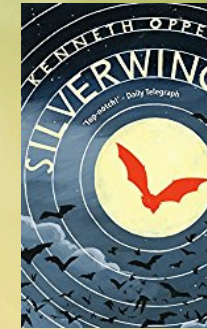


Festive fantasy

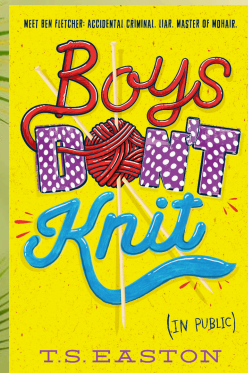

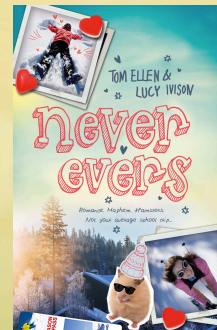

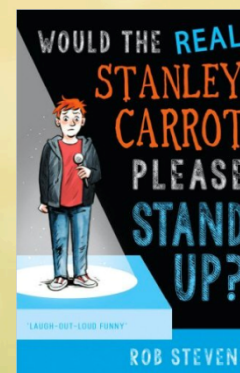


Following an incident with a lollipop lady and a stolen bottle, Ben reluctantly agrees to try and embrace his feminine side by joining a knitting group...
