SWIMMING ASSISTANT SEQ Level 1 Swimming Assistant

REPORTING

Swimming Assistants will work under the direct supervision of Level 2 Swimming Teachers during swim lessons and will report to the Swim School Coordinator or Duty Manager.

- To assist in the teaching of swimming to children following the National Plan for Teaching Swimming (NPTS) framework, encouraging swimmers in achieving their maximum potential.
- To work to high professional standards and to provide good customer service.

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

- To assist our Level 2 qualified teachers to deliver lessons to our high standards, creating an exceptional experience for our members.

- To assist in the delivery of the ASA Swim England Learn to Swim Programme.

- Be aware of any particular needs of individual swimmers and act accordingly, communicating effectively with the Swimming Teacher.

- To build positive relationships with children in swim lessons and help them achieve their swimming goals.
- To set up and put away any equipment needed for lessons.
