

Sandford on Thames

Dear Mr Ross-Barker

In reply to your circular letter I enclose photo and a few particulars of military service of the late 2nd Lt R.T.Hewer; –

At outbreak of war he was Sergt. In Berks Yeo: and called to colours. He went with Regt. to Egypt, was there promoted Sqn s/m. Went with part of Regt. to Galipoli (sic), took part (in the Abingdon Troop) in the storming of Burnt Hill. Fell ill with fever and jaundice, was three months in Hosp. Came home to take Commission in Regt., rejoined them in Palestine and took part in all the heavy fighting up to and just after the fall of Jaffa. Was killed on the 21 Nov. 1917 while “observing” for their Artillery.
