

Sergeant Staniland was educated at Royse's School
Arlington. When he left there at the age of sixteen.
He was apprenticed to Davis' Engineering Works, & after
gaining experience with other firms, he was on the
outbreak of war at Messrs. Singer & Co. of Coventry where
his name appears on the Roll of Honour. He enlisted
in Kitchener's army in September 1914 & was drafted
to the 10th Gloucesters. He went to France in
August 1915 & was killed in his first engagement
at the battle of Loos September 25th 1915.
