## Performance of The Comedy of Errors: Tuesday 24 February

As part of the curriculum at Abingdon School, we are committed to introducing your son to Shakespeare and engendering what we hope will become a lifelong love of his work and of the theatre.

An exciting opportunity has arisen for the boys to watch a production of *The Comedy of Errors*. The internationally acclaimed Propeller, a theatre company dedicated to performing Shakespeare's plays, are currently touring their 'Pocket' version of *The Comedy of Errors* and have agreed to bring the production to Abingdon. The performance will take place within the school day (periods 6 and 7) and will include an opportunity for the boys to talk to the actors about the production and their experience of performing Shakespeare.
