



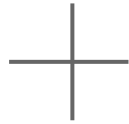

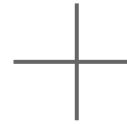

What do the boys study?

A wide range of core subjects so that options are kept open at this stage.

- English
- Maths
- Science
- History
- Computing
- PSHCE
- Geography
- Religious Studies
- Art
- Design Technology
- French or German
- Physical Education

What do the boys study?

Two optional subjects:

- Ancient History
- Latin
- Greek (for beginners)
- Drama
- Music
- A new language:
 - French
 - German
 - Spanish
 - Mandarin Chinese

Science

- Biology, Chemistry and Physics taught by specialist teachers
- Three lessons per week
- Approximately one term of each subject taught in rotation

Modern Languages

- German or French as a continuing language
- Spanish, German, French or Chinese as beginners' languages
- Must continue with at least one *European Foreign Language* for GCSE

Setting

- Taught in ability sets for Maths, Science and Latin. Summer exams are used as a guide.
- Other subjects are taught in mixed ability groups

Considerations

- Some combinations may prove to be impossible to timetable
- It is sometimes necessary to withdraw an option if numbers are uneconomical
- Think ahead to the 4th year


