ABINGDON SCHOOL CHARITY WALK

Thursday 25 September 2014

The Lower School and Middle School pupils and staff of Abingdon School are undertaking a sponsored walk from Dorchester-on-Thames along the Thames Path back to Abingdon (a distance of about 10 miles) to raise funds for three charities:

Blue Skye Thinking- is a charity which supports research so that all children diagnosed with brain tumours will have a better chance of survival and a better quality of life post treatment. The Charity is run by volunteers and all money donated goes directly to the forefront of Research and Treatment.

Emmaus Oxford- is a local homeless charity that provides a home for as long as someone needs it, as well as meaningful work in their social enterprise. This works to help to restore feeling of self-esteem and give these people the opportunity to regain control of their lives, and therefore overcome the homelessness.

AGAPE- works with young people in Moldova, the poorest country in Europe. Abingdon School has been working with this charity since 2000. For the last ten years sixth formers from Abingdon have helped to run summer camps for under-privileged children there.

GIFT AID: If you pay income tax or capital gains tax, by signing in the Gift Aid box you are making your donation tax efficient. **We can only claim this if we have the full name of the person, including title, and the postcode – please follow the example below.** The school is able to claim 25p in every £1 back from HM Revenue and Customs so will be able to donate that extra 25p to the four charities as well. This amounted to over £4,000 last time. Thank you.
