Theatre Trip for GCSE Drama students to "Observe the Sons of Ulster Marching Towards the Somme", Oxford Playhouse, Wednesday 28 September 2016

I write to inform you of a theatre trip we are organising as part of your son's GCSE Drama course. We have booked tickets to see an evening performance of Frank McGuinness' play **Observe the Sons of Ulster Marching Towards the Somme** at the Oxford Playhouse on Wednesday 29 September at 7.30pm.

This production will serve as the basis for a live theatre evaluation exercise that is a key part of both 4th and 5th year courses. Tickets are available on a first come, first served basis. This letter sets out the proposed arrangements. *Please see the consent form at the foot of this letter and return it as soon as possible so that I can confirm places on this trip. I am now able to accept an email authorisation but if you opt to reply in that way, please ensure you provide all the information required on the form.*

On the day of the trip - Wednesday 28 September - students will have a hot meal in the Dining Hall at 5.30pm. We will then travel to the Oxford Playhouse in a Tappins coach, departing from the Abingdon School Coach Park at 6.15pm. After the show, which finishes c. 10.00pm, we will return to the Abingdon Coach Park on Faringdon Road at about 10.30pm and we ask parents to collect their sons from the coach park at this point. Alternatively, you may collect your son from the front of the Oxford Playhouse on Beaumont Street, Oxford, provided you can be in place as soon as the show ends. Or, if your son lives in Oxford, and you are happy with this arrangement, he can, with your authorisation to us, make his own way home. *Please indicate clearly on the form which of these options you have chosen*.

The cost of the hot meal, theatre ticket and coach travel is expected to be in the region of £25 per person (depending on final numbers). The final cost would be added to your next end of term bill. The trip will be supervised by Mr Taylor and other members of the drama department at Abingdon. All standard risk assessment procedures will be carried out in advance. Please indicate whether you are happy for your son to participate in this trip by completing the form accompanying this letter and returning it by Saturday 24 September to Katie Bond, the Abingdon Drama Assistant.
