3rd year Strasbourg Trip 2017

The French department is delighted to offer your son the opportunity to attend our 4-day visit to Strasbourg, which will be taking place from Thursday 14 December to Sunday 17 December 2017 and run jointly with St Helen and St Katharine's. This visit is for boys studying French in the 3rd year this academic year.

The cost of the trip will be approximately £400 to include travel, accommodation, excursions, meals and insurance. The exact cost will depend on the number of participants and the exchange rate. There are 25 places available which will be allocated on a first come first served basis.
