## **3rd Year Induction Day**

Further to my letter sent out in the mailing on Friday 18 January, I am writing again to give you some further information about the forthcoming 3rd Year induction day on **Tuesday 25 June 2019 at 9am.** 

I am looking forward to welcoming your son into the Middle School. Although he knows the school well, we have organised an induction day in June on which he can meet his new housemaster and tutor as well as a large number of the new boys who will be joining the school. We have planned a fun and interactive day so that boys can get a good taste of what is to come.

There will be the opportunity to take part in various activities including music and sport. Boys are encouraged to bring their musical instruments if they wish to take part in the musical activity. There is a link to a sign up form at the end of this letter.

Parents are invited to attend a tea party at 3pm in Lacies Court Gardens (or Sports Hall entertainment suite in the event of wet weather) when they come to collect their boys. During this time there will be an opportunity for you to meet some of the staff who will be working closely with your son on a daily basis.

This will be a chance for you to meet your son's Tutor and Housemaster, informally over drinks, at the start of the new academic year as your son is settling the Middle School.
