Foodbank Collection

From Monday 3 February to Friday 7 February the Charities Committee are holding a collection for a local foodbank. The committee will then be taking donations to the Abingdon Emergency Foodbank for them to distribute to those in need.

If you could encourage your sons to bring in an item to donate it would really be appreciated. It would be fantastic if we can take a large number of items to the foodbank at the end of the week. Last year the collection was very successful and we donated over 1000 items.

The items particularly required for donation are:

- Bags of sugar (both 500g and 1kg bags)
- Coffee
- Deodorant
- Shaving foam/gel
- Washing machine tablets/pods
- Fruit squash

Other items needed include:

- Jars of pasta sauce
- Tinned meat and vegetables
- Rice
- Tea or hot chocolate
- Tins of fish
- Cereals
- · Tins of puddings
- Long life fruit juices
- Biscuits
- Jams etc
- Tins of fruit
- Pasta
- Tinned soup
- Baked beans
