


If you liked the BBC series, chances are you'll love the book behind it.



Now two civilizations are on a collision course, ready to do anything to survive. As the fates of species hang in the balance, who will emerge as the true heirs of this new Earth?







So when a vengeful spirit starts wreaking havoc, it's down to Peter to save the day, or die trying.




Harry has lived many lifetimes - literally. When he dies, he is reborn, in the same place at the same time, but with the knowledge of all the lives he has lived before.

It will be a fight to the death.



As each gets to know the other, Aristotle and Dante learn the most important truths about themselves - and about the kind of people they want to be.



Enter Dylan's long-time crush, Freddie Alton. Then Kayla discovers that the Nightmares are staying in the very same hotel as they are...



















He's small, but fast - and deadly with a bow...

He's going to to use his very particular set of skills to get revenge against the villains who put his dad in prison - and to strike a blow for freedom.




Twelve-year-old Bill is adrift in a tiny rowing boat in the middle of the ocean.

Finally they make landfall, but the stranger who greets them is not what he seems - and as they head back out onto the water, a dark shadow is on their tail....




A boy. A wolf. The legend lives on...

This is the long-awaited seventh book in the Wolf Brother series. Like all of the books, it can be read as a standalone story.




Twelve-year-old Alex receives an old tin robot in the post. With it is a note from his grandfather; it reads, simply 'This one is special'.

Can Alex safely harness the robot's power? Or will it fall into the wrong - dangerous - hands?




Moving house can be great fun. But not for Noah Bradley.

To save him, Ellie must prove to The City who he really is - but to do so puts her at risk of revealing her own dangerous secret...




The thirteenth book in the Skulduggery Pleasant series sees Valkyrie and her mentor tested like never before.

Only by crawling through darkness will she once more be able to stand in the light...




The latest instalment in the Alex Rider saga sees the series get a major reboot.


To claim your prize, bring in a list of the titles you read and the genre, signed off by a parent at the beginning of next term
