Results

In 2017-2020

23 out of 40 candidates have got A*s in Latin, 13 As and 3 Bs

8 out of 16 candidates have got A*s in Greek, 7 As

4 out of 18 candidates have got A*s in AH, 7 As, 6 Bs

Over the last 6 years

Over **50%** candidates in Greek and Latin have got an **A*** and over **89% A*/A**;

Over **60%** in Ancient History have got **A*/A**

University Classics

Over the last 13 years, 32 boys have won places to study Classics or Ancient History at Oxbridge.

In the last 3 years 7 boys have won places at Oxford for Classical courses, 3 at UCL, 1 at Durham

In the last three years 5 OAs got Double Firsts in Oxford Classics and won prizes in Finals, two getting a Congratulatory First

Numerous others have won places at other top universities for Classics, including Bristol, St Andrew's, Edinburgh, Exeter, UCL, KCL, Bristol, Nottingham, Durham, Warwick, Manchester.
