
Easter Egg Hunt


You need to go on a trip round Norfolk using the roads and distances marked, collecting Easter eggs at each place visited.

This map shows the distances between places and the possible routes between them.




The list below is the number of eggs in each place. You have to choose a route that will gain the most eggs, without travelling any more than 250 miles.




If you travel from Norwich to Swaffham, you gain 15 eggs: 10 for being in Norwich and 5 for getting to Swaffham.



If you then travel back from Swaffham to Norwich, you DO NOT get the eggs again; once you collect them they are gone!

Here is an example of a possible route:



Summary

You need to go on a trip round Norfolk using the roads and distances marked.


Each town has a different number of eggs. Once you collect eggs from a place, you cannot collect them again.


You may travel a maximum of 250 miles.

You must start and end at Great Yarmouth.

Each group should have at least three routes.

The group with the most eggs wins!
