## PSHCE Programme of Study, 3rd and 4th years, Summer term 2021

Here is an outline of the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year PSHCE programmes of study for the Summer term. Students will be working through the following topics with their PSHCE teachers. I would encourage you to discuss these topics as they come up this term in order to enhance what we are doing in School.

## In the 3rd year - Relationships and Sex Education

Students will be studying the following topics this term:

- Lesson 1 Love and commitment (the lesson will take place in weeks 1-2 of the Summer term)
- Lesson 2 Marriage and relationships (the lesson will take place in weeks 3-4 of term)
- Lesson 3 Parenting and healthy relationships (the lesson will take place in weeks 5-6 of term)
- Lesson 4 Feminism and women's reproductive health (the lesson will take place in weeks 7-8 of term)
- Lesson 5 Reproductive choices, pregnancy, miscarriage and the law surrounding these issues (the lesson will take place in weeks 9-10 of term)

We have also planned a *Relationships and Sex Education* morning on Wednesday 26 May with the School Doctor, external nurses and Loudmouth Theatre Company. I will write to you with more information about this event nearer the time.

## In the 4th year - Relationships and Sex Education

Students will be studying the following topics this term.

- Lesson 1 Honour based and domestic violence, FGM (the lesson will take place in weeks 1-2 of term)
- Lesson 2 Sexual consent (the lesson will take place in week 3-4 of term)
- Lesson 3 Sexual harassment (the lesson will take place in weeks 5-6 of term)
- Lessons 4+5 Pornography and sexting (the lessons will take place in weeks 7-10 of term)
