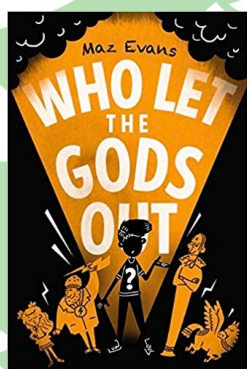
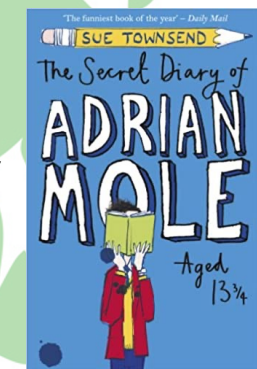
Seasonal scares
