Dear Parents / Carers

Lower Sixth Geography field trip to Snowdonia, Sunday 12 – Wednesday 15 June 2022

I wrote to you previously about the above compulsory Geography field trip for Lower Sixth Geographers in the summer term.

I wanted to let you know that on the next bill, there will be a charge of £270 added.

This is to secure accommodation and transport to and from the activity centre in Wales, Plas Tan y Bwlch in the Snowdonia National Park; https://www.snowdonia.gov.wales/study-centre).

The full expected cost of the trip is c.£400 and the remaining balance will be added to the Michaelmas term 2022 bill.

As a reminder, the itinerary is as follows;

- leave the school coach park promptly at 9am on Sunday 12 June and visit Birmingham en route (packed lunch required)
- On Monday 13 June and Tuesday 14 June there will be a host of different (largely physical) fieldwork activities in the Snowdonia National Park and surrounding area.
- On Wednesday 15 June, we visit Wrexham on the return journey, to continue with human fieldwork. We will not return in time for bus departures that evening

You will receive a consent form via email ahead of each trip and we would appreciate timely completion, so that all elements are finalised before the trip itself.
