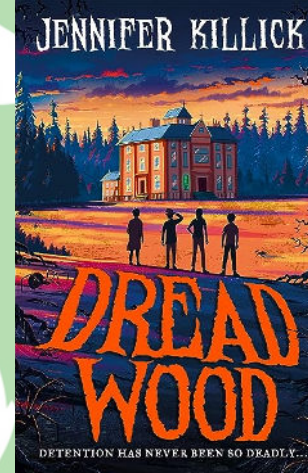
Festive fantasy
