Seasonal science fiction



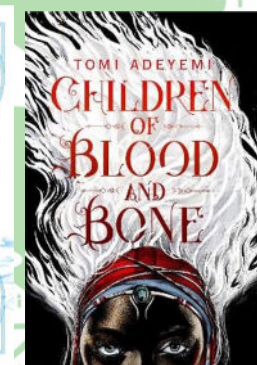
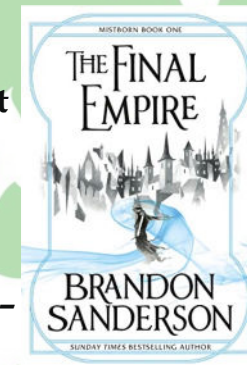
