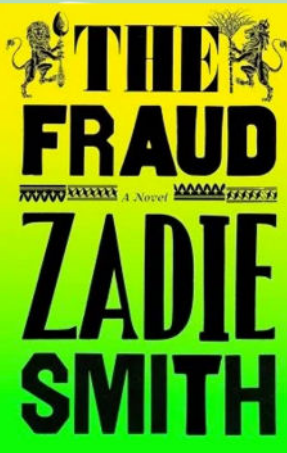
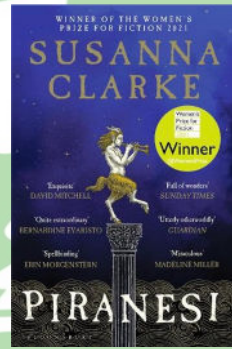
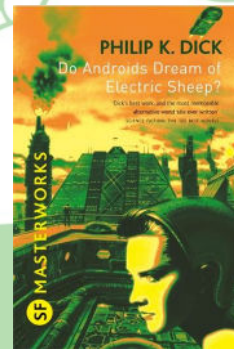
A whale washes up on a beach, whose bones are claimed by a twelve-year-old girl with big ambitions and an even bigger imagination, fiercely determined to do things differently.



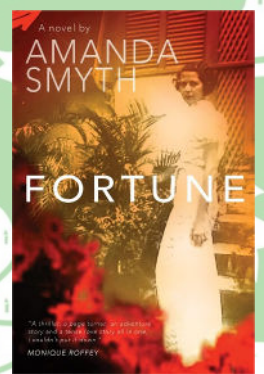
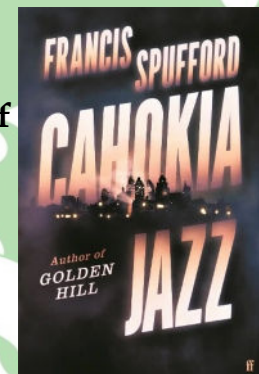
Seasonal speculation
